Some days were cold, wet, and very challenging and others were warm, sunny and very powerful. It is not always easy and predictable but at times very difficult and agonizing. Prayer at times is hard work and must be done by faith and patience. Rewards usually are not seen in this

present life but be sure God our Father seeks men and women who are willing to lay their lives down for others in prayer and intercession. I was released many times in singing with and in the Spirit and I know this brought much joy to God and really ignited power within me. Faith to see cities and regions changed came rather easily as I was in the Spirit. Following is a brief summary of each city we visited and I prayer walked in:

~Fort Mills, SC- Morning Star Ministries- Powerful prayer meeting, equipping, training, touching the nations, prophetic insights, relevant information.

~Charlotte, NC- Growing, groaning, opportunity city, major hub for outpouring, some conflict, riot or revival.

~Moravian Falls, NC- God's Mountain, revelation, powerful, pure, potential, providential history, God stories, connecting, inspiring, beautiful.

~Asheville, NC- Mountains, creation, potential. Conflict, deception, compromise. I feel God's desire and destiny for this city.

~Cleveland, TN- Perry Stone's Ministry, Mannafest. Pure, powerful, positive, potential, Israel lovers, sound doctrine, life giving, faithful stewards.

~Chattanooga, TN- Lovely, charming, River City, freedom, revelation, understanding, needed for revival, inviting. At times self-absorbed, nice place to pray.

~Nashville, TN- Growing rapidly, great potential for outpouring, very gifted, great destiny, creativity displayed, idolatry, self-serving, distracted, somewhat deceived. This city challenged me and I am still praying about my part there. This city could be one of the most important places in God's plan for the last day harvest.

~Birmingham, AL- Cry for freedom and justice. Progress with some problems. Walls of prejudice still here. Amazing potential for major break throughs.

~Montgomery, AL- I loved this capital city. Connections, compassion, caring, content, some conflict, the More of God city, strong prayer, humble servants.

~Mobile, AL- Port city with great potential, some tricky strongholds, industry, more creativity being released. Freedom is coming, nice place to visit.

~Jackson, MS- Many churches, poverty but faith found. Needs revelation, dreams dashed, but God loves this city. I felt deep compassion as I walked and prayed.

~Indianola/Greenville, MS- A place I lived 43 years ago when I was 24 years old. Tired, tried and tested city. In this city God did some amazing things to me and for me. The revisiting and reconnecting touched me deeply as the Lord Himself confirmed His love for me and my old friend L.C. Jennings whom I hadn't seen or talked to for 43 years.

The last 2 months brought to me a greater understanding of the time and season we are living in. God showed me many times how much he loves all people regardless of the color of their skin or how rich or poor they are.

May all of us be faithful to the will of God and together love Him, worship Him and serve Him daily. The blood still speaks mercy, redemption, salvation, forgiveness and a big “I love you”.

Please keep me in prayer as I prayer walk New Orleans, Baton Rouge and Lafayette, LA and Beaumont, Houston and Dallas, TX during Part 3 of my prayer walk. I will leave March 31 and fly home April 14.
